

# Lawn & Garden AUGUST To Do List



## MAINTAIN

- Water plants deeply in the early morning. Avoid watering during the hottest part of the day as this can burn plants.
- Watch for powdery mildew, which is caused by moisture and humidity.
- When temperature is over 85 degrees, avoid chemical applications such as fertilizer, fungicide or insecticide.

## ANNUALS & PERENNIALS

- Divide and transplant perennials after blooming.
- Prune vigorous climbers and train around trellises while growth is soft.
- Continue deadheading.
- In colder zones (1-3), begin moving houseplants indoors to acclimate.

## LAWNS

- Aerate and dethatch lawn.
- If there is plenty of rainfall, apply fertilizer.

## PLAN AHEAD
